Discover life on a re-created Tidewater Virginia farm during the Revolution.



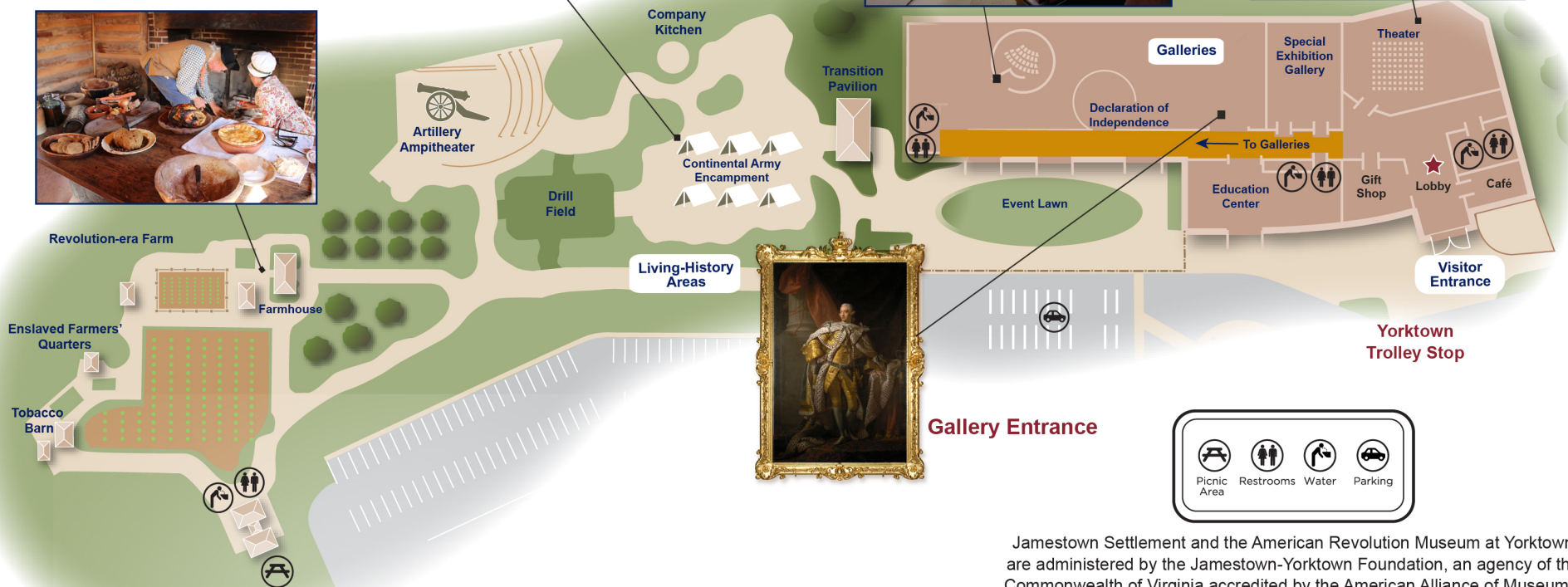
Siege Theater
